Speakers must bring their slides on a portable drive to the Conference hall so slides can be uploaded to the presentation computer.

## Poster

A poster session is a graphic presentation of an author's research.

The poster size is 1M\*1M.

Poster material should be well labeled and legible from a distance of 10 to 15 feet.

The title should be the same as the title submitted with the abstract and appear in bold face at the top.
